NCYFA STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

1. Students should be proficient with donning and doffing Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA).
 2. Students must bring their own turnout gear and airpack along with one spare air bottle.
 3. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) must be [NFPA-1971](#) compliant, and consist of boots, pants, coat, hood, helmet, and structural firefighting gloves. Coat and pants must include lining. Helmet must be an approved firefighting helmet (not a rescue helmet).
 4. Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) with facepiece must be [NFPA-1981](#) compliant. Air bottles must be in date.
- Students should wear comfortable breathable (cotton) clothing and sneakers-type footgear (no open toed sandals, flip-flops, crocs, etc.). A NCYFA T-shirt will be provided to all Academy students.
 - The NCYFA will provide lunch and snacks but if you have allergies or require a special diet, you may want to bring your own food.
 - The NCYFA will provide students with water which will be required to be regularly consumed throughout the day to stay hydrated. Highly caffeinated and stimulant-containing “energy” drinks are prohibited.
 - Students may want to bring some cash for vendors and snacks while at the NCYFA.
